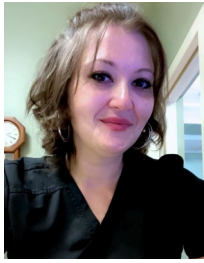

Courtlyn:



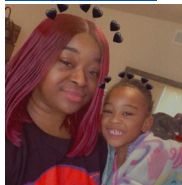
